



2007 Mary Kathleen Cabernet Merlot

Background

Mary Kathleen is named after family matriarch, Mary Kathleen Lloyd, one of the founders of Coriole. It is produced from three small, select vineyards on Coriole's estate - planted between 1968 and 1986. The wine was first produced in 1992.

Tasting Notes

Aromatics of redcurrant, ripe mint and perfumed rose petals. With breathing, polished wood and a smokey cigar box aromas become evident.

The palate shows bright fruit - lifted berries and blackcurrant with a creamy texture. A brooding wine with structural tannin and good length. As with previous vintages of MK, this 2007 will age long and gracefully.
