



2005 Lloyd Reserve Shiraz

Background

Lloyd Reserve Shiraz is produced from a single vineyard at Coriole that was planted in 1919. The soil and roots are extremely deep and generally no irrigation is required. It is one of Langton's classified wines of Australia.

A coolish late summer in 2005 produced concentrated well structured wines. The Lloyd Reserve is produced in open fermenters with hand plunging and spends over 22 months in small French oak.

Tasting Notes

This very concentrated wine exudes aromas in the black fruits, bitter chocolate, coffee bean and cocoa spectrum whilst the intense palate is satisfyingly rich, dense and long. This wine can be enjoyed young or cellared for many years to come.
